Walt bought in a special display case that had a frame of bees inside. We were able to watch the bees as they worked. Some students were even lucky enough to watch a bee being born!

The Grade 3 team, KPS Pocket Rockets, had different students competing this time and also managed to perform a fabulous routine.








Every student had so much fun that they are keen to keep training and compete at the next competition in August.
